A few important upcoming dates and reminders:

- Veterans Day Closure: The National Office will be closed on Tuesday, November 11, in observance of Veterans Day.
- Thanksgiving Closure: We will also be closed November 26–28 for the Thanksgiving holiday.
- Online Store Deadline: Our online store closes on December 12. Please plan ahead for any chapter orders before that date.
- Membership Deadline for Scholarship Eligibility: All senior members who wish to apply for scholarships must be officially listed on our rolls by December 12, 2025. Please doublecheck your chapter rosters to ensure all student memberships are current before the deadline.
