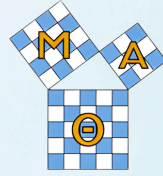

As always, we would love to talk through any ideas and look forward to meeting students at our monthly student delegate meetings!

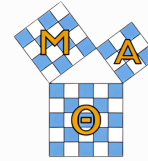
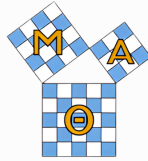
