The Andree Award, named in honor of Mu Alpha Theta founders Richard and Josephine Andree, is awarded to a student who is interested in becoming a mathematics teacher. Mu Alpha Theta will present one \$2,500 Andree Award to a graduating high school member and one to a current or former member now in college. The winner may choose to receive the \$2,500 as a scholarship or as a cash prize.

Each chapter may submit one nomination per year, to be decided by the chapter sponsor.
