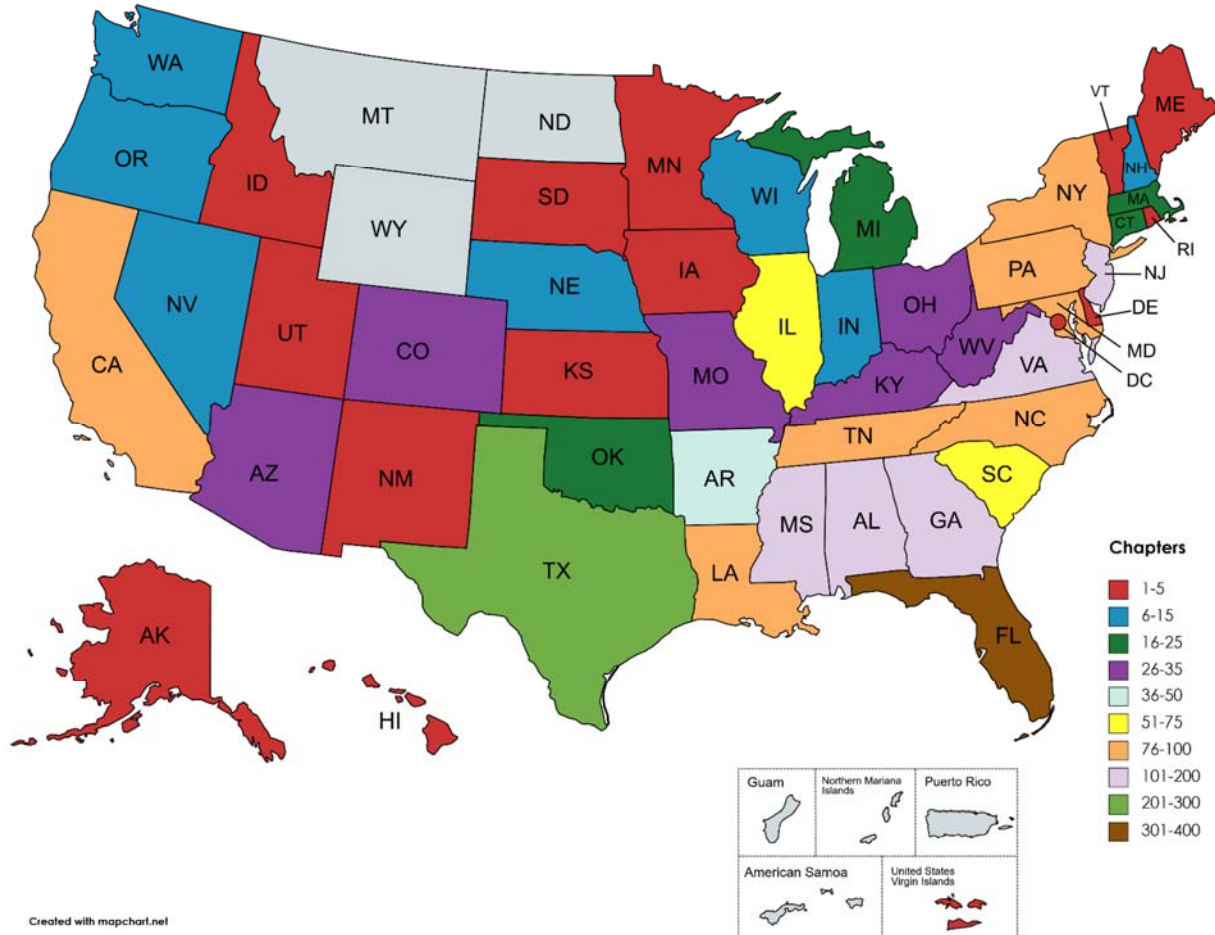
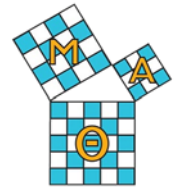

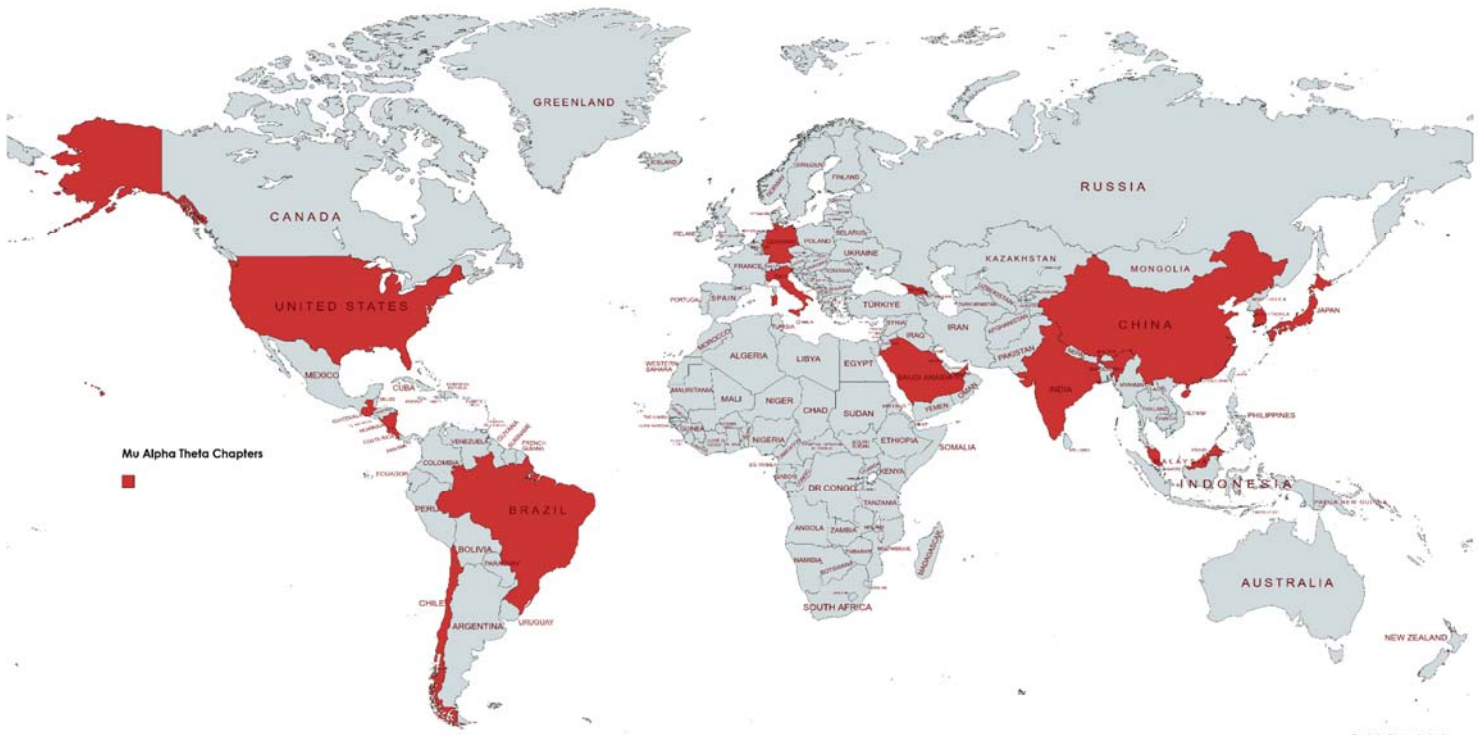

### MU ALPHA THETA CHAPTERS AROUND THE WORLD



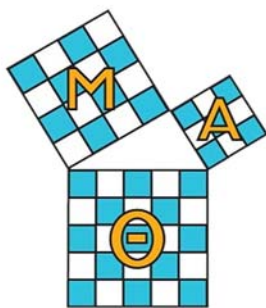
Since this map was drawn, Turkey has added a chapter!
