Diane Rubin Service Award 2019

The Rubin Award was established in 2004 by the governing council of Mu Alpha Theta. This award was named in honor of Diane Rubin who worked tirelessly at the national office of Mu Alpha Theta for twenty years before her retirement in December 2003.

The award will be presented to the Mu Alpha Theta chapter that has a history of outstanding mathematics service to its community for at least two years. This service must promote interest in mathematics and benefit a group other than its own chapter. No school may receive the award more than once in a five-year period.

The winning chapter will receive a \$5,000 cash prize and a plaque, which will be presented to the winner at our national convention. A representative of the chapter need not be present to win.
