



1. The words are just written backwards. It says: "WELCOME TO THE CODE PROBLEMS"
2. TRIANGLE AND INTEGRAL
3. Total up each group of 3 numbers and take the corresponding letter of the alphabet. Decoded, it reads: "The paradox is a cunning beast"
4. The quote says: "All bad precedents began as justifiable measures."
5. The quote says: "The optimist proclaims we live in the best of all possible worlds; and the pessimist fears this is true."
6. Starting reading with the 5<sup>th</sup> word, then the 6<sup>th</sup> word, then the 7<sup>th</sup> word, etc, you will get the message: "The test will start early Tuesday morning."
7. This is the sentence: "To be or not to be, that is the question" written in WINGDINGS, any punctuation.
8. The code says: "THIS CIPHER WAS ONCE USED BY FREEMASONS" and the Pigpen symbols are created as follows:

10. IMPORTANT
11. The quote says: "WELL DONE FOR DECIPHERING THIS MESSAGE USING FREQUENCY ANALYSIS."
12. American Standard Code for Information Interchange
13. The bands names are represented by their alphanumeric values, then doubled. The bands are: QUEEN, ROLLING STONES, GREEN DAY, BEATLES, DIRE STRAITS
14. If you look carefully, you will see nearly all the letters are made out of lines with no curves. The only curved letters spell: CORPUS
15. It says, THIS IS THE LAST QUESTION
